

Parish Council monthly update

Crimes of note:

- 08/03/25 – Threats to cause damage – Report of unknown youth making threats to damage victims property. No lines of enquiry to identify youth such as CCTV/witnesses so report filed.
- 09/03/25 – Theft – report that an unknown person has stolen victim's wallet from their pocket.
- 10/03/25 – Assault - Report that victim came to the area with people he thought were friends however they have punched and kicked him causing a fractured skull. All 3 suspects identified, arrested and charged with GBH with intent.
- 15/03/25 – Criminal Damage – report that unknown youths have superglued dustcaps of victim's car. Incident not reported until the following day and no known witnesses/CCTV therefore report filed.
- 15/03/25 – Dangerous Dog – report of child being bitten by a dog. Upon investigation, no serious injury was caused, dog was described as a puppy and was being playful rather than showing aggression and victim did not want to support a prosecution therefore report filed.
- 25/03/25 – Various – Report of vehicle crashed & abandoned, small amount of drugs found in vehicle, vehicle later reported to have been taken without owners consent, nearby report of a burglary of a business premises. Suspect located nearby and arrested for all offences. Investigation ongoing.

Anti-social behaviour and other incidents of note:

- 02/03/25 – Drug Driving - Report of a group of people in vehicles doing ballons. Vehicles drove off during the call and caller was unable to obtain any number plates therefore no further action taken.
- 03/03/25 – Sus Event – Report of persons forcefully putting multiple dogs into the back of a van however no number plates provided therefore no further action taken.
- 05/03/25 – Nuisance Vehicle – Report of youths riding around on motorbikes with no number plates. PC Kinrade off duty, incident was broadcast for any other officers who may be in the area but nobody available to attend.
- 08/03/25 – Nuisance Vehicle – Report of unknown persons riding a motorbike with no helmets. PC Kinrade off duty so later obtained CCTV but insufficient quality to identify riders.
- 08/03/25 – Nuisance Vehicle – Report of youth riding small off road bike. PC Kinrade off duty so later obtained CCTV. This bike was later seized from other youths in incident below. All identified youths who have been on the bike have since been visited by PC Kinrade and they and their parents warned of consequences if they are caught again.
- 09/03/25 – Report of youths riding off road bike. PC Kinrade attended, vehicle seized. All identified youths who have been on the bike have since been visited by PC Kinrade and they and their parents warned of consequences if they are caught again.

Parish Council monthly update

- 17/03/25 – Drink/Drug driving - Report of persons drinking alcohol and doing balloons whilst in vehicle. Officers attended driver breath tested and blew 0, officers deemed driver not to be impaired. Drugs search conducted and ballon cannisters found so occupants dealt with for drugs possession.
- 19/03/25 – Nuisance Youths – Report that over the last few months a group of youths have been behaving antisocially. No specific incident ongoing at the time. PC Kinrade has spoken with caller about the issues reported, some of which are mentioned above.
- 19/03/25 – Nuisance Youths – Report of youths with a catapult. Incident not reported until the following day. PC Kinrade has conducted CCTV enquiries but has been unable to identify youths.
- 21/03/25 – Nuisance Youths – Report of youths with a catapult (different group to above incident). PC Kinrade attended, youths stopped & searched. 4 catapults, stone, hunting lamp & knuckleduster seized. All parents informed and investigation ongoing in relation to the knuckleduster.
- 23/03/25 – Sus Event – Report of vehicle parked up with no number plates. PC Kinrade attended by which point number plates were back on the vehicle. Checked vehicle identity, spoke with nearby owner who has recently purchased vehicle. No concerns.
- 26/03/25 – Sus Event – Report of vehicle parked up in unusual place. Caller spoke to occupant who claimed to have been having sex in the car. Caller unable to see who else was in the car. Vehicle had driven off by the time of report and no other concerns raised therefore no action taken.

Other news:

- 07/03/25 – Drugs – Officers pulled over a vehicle and conducted a drugs search, occupant arrested for possession of drugs with intent to supply. Driver wasn't the owner/insured party therefore also arrested for theft of motor vehicle & no insurance. Investigation ongoing.
- 09/03/25 – Traffic Offence - Vehicle stopped having been seen driving through a red light. Drink & drug tests completed which were clear therefore driver reported for red light offence. Will likely receive either educational course or points on driving licence & fine.
- 29/03/25 – Traffic offence – Officers stopped a vehicle, driver believed to be uninsured therefore vehicle seized.
- 30/03/25 – Drugs – officers conducted a drugs search, found small amount of cannabis therefore offender dealt with for drugs possession.
